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- Abstracts or full draft papers, **May 31st, 2026**
 - Acceptance Notification, **June 10th, 2026**
 - Camera Ready Papers, **July 10th, 2026**
 - Early Bird Registration Closure: **July 24th, 2026**
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- Late Registration Closure: **August 31st, 2026**
 - EUROSIM Congress 2026: **21-23 September 2026**
